# **Hive Calendar**

#### August Activities: Harvest and Medicate

Check for swarm cells each 7 to 10 days. Re-queen. Warm temperatures improve the effect of all mite medications. Use medications after supers are off and per manufacturer's recommendation. Remove and extract capped supers. Collect and freeze pollen for use next spring. Bottle and sell honey and beeswax.

Daniel received his PhD From the University of Kansas and currently teaches at Green River Community College. He has been part of the North East Kansas Beekeepers Association and the Alamo Area Beekeepers Association. His research focuses on the cognitive capability of honeybees, specifically foragers, and their ability to find food. He has measured honeybee decision making with respect to time, space, and a host of other associations and can infer the honeybee reasoning capabilities.
