



## PSBA Board Member Commitments

These commitments, with board approval, may be adjusted to accommodate individual abilities by substituting equivalent contributions.

Board members will:

- Lead by example:** Be visible in the community, Represent PSBA, Demonstrate and evangelize good beekeeping practices and pursue beekeeper certification and other training to benefit PSBA
- Attend 3 Board meetings annually** and 75% of regular monthly meetings
- Read and Respond to Board emails or other inquiries as requested within 3 days of receipt
- Review the agenda and supporting materials prior to Board and committee meetings
- Fulfill at least **1 speaking event** on behalf of PSBA - to educate at a school, garden club, PSBA meeting, another beekeeping club, or other venue.
- Lead at least **1 apiary work party** per year and attend at least **1 additional work party** as an assistant
- Assist in raising funds, as agreed upon annually by the Board. **At a minimum**, lead or help manage **3 fundraising events** (honey sales booth, special event, class, or other board approved activity) to raise money for PSBA AND to educate beekeepers or the public.
- Recruit and encourage board service with PSBA from our membership – take steps to **nominate at least 1 candidate** for officer or trustee position before October 1 each year.
- Remain informed about PSBA’s mission, services, and policies and promote PSBA, as agreed annually by the Board.
